WHEREAS: It is fitting to set aside a day in honor of this man who has contributed so much to the growth and prosperity of the City of New Brighton;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, January 17, 1989 to be
