WHEREAS: In 1943, sponsored by Representative Telford V. Oraas, Hazel C. Johnson served as the first woman page of the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS: Her first duties as a legislative employee entailed a variety of responsibilities in the chief clerk's office; and

WHEREAS: During her 46 years of service with the House of Representatives, Hazel has held the positions of page, file clerk, assistant desk clerk, and has been desk clerk since 1967; and

WHEREAS: Hazel has had the crucial job of processing the paperwork of the House of Representatives floor sessions in her position as desk clerk, from which she is now retiring; and

WHEREAS: Hazel's quiet dedication to duty and her pleasing personality have earned her the professional and personal respect of those associated with her; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting to set aside a day in honor of this loyal and committed employee for the State of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, January 11, 1989 to be
