WHEREAS: This event not only makes for an exciting evening of sports entertainment, but also provides Minnesotans with an opportunity to help people in need; and

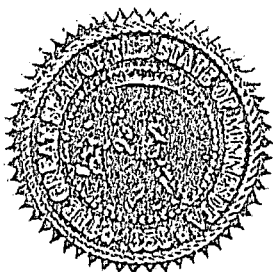
WHEREAS: This game is yet another example of "Minnesotans helping Minnesotans," which makes this state the great place that it is;
