



## Proclamation

**WHEREAS:** The goal of the Itasca Heart Project is to educate all residents of Itasca County about heart disease, to make them aware of their personal risk of heart disease and to provide services to assist them in living more "heart healthy" lives; and

**WHEREAS:** The Itasca Heart Project was founded locally by residents of Itasca County concerned about the health and welfare of their own people; and

**WHEREAS:** The Itasca Heart Project will be visible all over the county for at least two years -- at community events, in grocery stores and restaurants, in the workplace, at public health screenings and in medical clinics; and

**WHEREAS:** The Itasca Heart Project's primary objective is to improve the quality of life for the people of Itasca County, not to establish research data; and



in Minnesota in honor of the commencement of the Itasca Heart Project.


