WHEREAS: It is fitting that the members of this worthwhile organization be recognized for the outstanding service they provide communities in the State of Minnesota and elsewhere around the world;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 15-21, 1989, to be

in Minnesota.


