Co-curricular activities contribute toward developing well-rounded individuals and WHEREAS: expanding the awareness and capabilities of high school students beyond the academic world; and


Educational leaders, school boards, administrators, faculty, parents, and communities promote and expect quality in our co-curricular activity programs; and WHEREAS:
