WHEREAS: On January 14, 1989, the state's most outstanding seafood chef will be chosen at Minnesota's Third Annual Seafood Challenge;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 14, 1989 to be
