WHEREAS: We wish to express to the patients in the Minneapolis Veterans Administration Medical Center our concern, care and sincere appreciation;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February 14, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


