WHEREAS: Soup has been a traditional food source for centuries, brought over to America by a variety of cultures; and

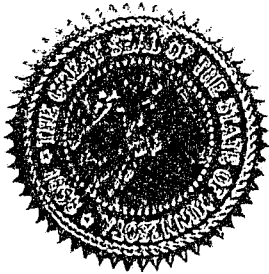
WHEREAS: Many soups have less than 100 calories per serving, and soup is available in enough varieties to suit the tastes of almost anyone in Minnesota; and
