WHEREAS: Soup has been a traditional food source for centuries, brought over to America by a

variety of cultures; and

WHEREAS: Many soups have less than 100 calories per serving, and soup is available in enough

varieties to suit the tastes of almost anyone in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Ninety-nine percent of American households buy soup each year, and Americans consume

about ten billion bowls annually;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January, 1989 to be

"NATIONAL SOUP MONTH"

in Minnesota.
