WHEREAS: Neal A. Vanselow's leadership has been responsible for the recruitment of several outstanding deans and directors who have made major contributions to the University; and


WHEREAS: Neal A. Vanselow has distinguished himself in many forms of service, not only to the University of Minnesota, but also to the state and nation;
