WHEREAS: *Up with People* is the international, educational and cultural program which is working to encourage understanding among people of all nations; and

WHEREAS: *Up With People's* impact stretches across six continents and has reached over eighteen million people; and

WHEREAS: In the past 20 years, *Up With People* has been seen live in concert by more than 17 million people in 48 countries; and

WHEREAS: An international cast of *Up with People* will be performing its two-hour musical show "Time for the Music" at the Northrop Auditorium in Minneapolis on January 17, 1989; and

WHEREAS: WCCO television and Signal Bank are sponsoring *Up With People's* local activities as a service to the people of the Twin Cities; and

WHEREAS: The *Up With People* cast will also participate in a week of community service activities throughout the Twin Cities; and

WHEREAS: In addition, the *Up with People* cast will spend the day and perform at the Minnesota State Capitol on Thursday, January 12;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 12, 1989 to be
