WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is a better place to live, due in part, to Walter's efforts;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, January 6, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


