
WHEREAS: The Minnesota Federation of Music Clubs is a component part of the National Federation and joins in the Parade with its notable purposes;

A M E R I C A N M U S I C M O N T H


In Minnesota, and urge all citizens to join in the observance of American Music Month through appreciation and enjoyment of American music.
