



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: As administrator of the Metropolitan Council's regional parks program, Bob Nethercut worked for more than a decade to see to it that today's and tomorrow's Minnesotans have excellent outdoor recreation opportunities; and

WHEREAS: In doing so, Bob helped save the most beautiful and undisturbed land areas remaining in the Twin Cities from development; and

WHEREAS: Because of his tireless efforts, \$170 million has been spent since 1974 to create a regional park system that enjoys growing popularity and is the envy of the nation; and

WHEREAS: Bob has also served the community as a village council member and mayor of Arden Hills, and as a board member of the YMCA, North Como Presbyterian Church and the Presbyterian Church of the Way, and Together, Inc.; and

WHEREAS: Bob Nethercut is retiring from the Council after 21 years of service that involved solid waste planning and outreach to the community in addition to parks administration;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, January 26, 1989 to be

BOB NETHERCUT DAY

in Minnesota.
