WHEREAS: The Eighth Annual IDS Climb-a-thon for the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation will take place on January 23, 1989;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, January 28, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


