



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Julia Zehnle has worked continuously for the Welfare/ Social Service office in Todd County for fifty years; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Merit System has confirmed that Julia has the longest continuous employment with a county welfare agency; and

WHEREAS: Since Julia has worked as a social worker since she started with Todd County on February 15, 1939, though her job title has changed to Visitor, Caseworker, Social Worker and Child Welfare Worker; and

WHEREAS: In 1967 Julia was promoted to Social Service Supervisor, and has worked at this position for seven years before returning to a social worker position in 1974, and she is currently serving as the nursing home placement worker; and

WHEREAS: Julia was honored in 1953 by the Department of Public Welfare for her superior work with child welfare and mental retardation cases, and in 1968, the Northern Pines Mental Health Center presented her with a plaque for Meritorious Service; and

WHEREAS: Julia has proven that she is a hardworking and devoted employee, and she has been a special blessing to families making arrangements to place their relatives in nursing homes; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting to set aside a day to honor Julia for her outstanding dedication to Todd County and to the State of Minnesota;
