



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Productivity and competitiveness are based upon a deep understanding of the principles of quality; and

WHEREAS: The principles of quality management advocated by the Minnesota Council for Quality -- management leadership, employee participation, sensitivity to customers, continuous improvement and employee training -- must be widely disseminated and understood; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota section of the American Society for Quality Control has labored, through its membership, to disseminate, and teach these principles; and

WHEREAS: The 1989 Minnesota Quality Conference is to be held March 1st and 2nd, 1989, in Bloomington, Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 1st through 8th 1989 to be

MINNESOTA QUALITY WEEK

in Minnesota.

Further, I urge all citizens to adopt the principles of quality in their place of work and as a philosophy of life, and I thank the Minnesota Council for Quality and the American Society for Quality Control for their efforts in this area.
