WHEREAS: Middle level education is a distinctive level; and

WHEREAS: The period of early adolescence is especially important as youth 10-14 undergo

extensive physical, social, emotional, and intellectual growth; and

WHEREAS: The educational experiences of youth during early adolescence, largely mold their adult

personalities and values; and

WHEREAS: The role of parents as partners in these educational experiences is equally important;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of March 12-18, 1989 to be

NATIONAL MIDDLE EDUCATION WEEK

in Minnesota, and that the public be urged to become fully acquainted with school programs serving early adolescent youth and recommitted to playing an active role in the education of tomorrow's adults.
