WHEREAS: Senior citizens believe strongly in working together with other groups and generations to improve the quality of life for everyone; and

WHEREAS: Senior citizens care deeply about maintaining independence and preserving dignity; and

WHEREAS: Senior citizens want the right to make decisions about their own medical care now and for the future; and

WHEREAS: Senior citizens participate actively in the legislative process to pursue important issues such as transportation, in-home care, and living wills;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 30, 1989 to be
