## ORDINANCE NO. 89

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NEW YORK MILLS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED LAND (UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA) ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS

whereas, a certain petition dated <u>December 5</u>, 1988, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the <u>13th</u> day of <u>December</u>, 1988; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 4.95 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the city limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and
WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the
city limits at the eastern boundary thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Newton Township Board has executed a Consent to Annexation and the boundaries of no municipality other than New York Mills abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed;

Section 1. The city council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests fo the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said terrritory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof;

A part of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter (W 1/2 of SW 1/4) of Section 9, in Township 135 North, Range 37 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian described as follows: To find the point of beginning commence at the southwest corner of said Section 9, thence on an assumed bearing of North and along the west line of said Section 9 a distance of 528.00 feet; thence at right angles East a distance of 33.0 feet to the easterly right of way line of the existing street, this to be the point of beginning; thence from the point of beginning North and along said right of way and parallel with the said west line of Section 9 a distance of 300.0 feet; thence at right angles East 188.0 feet; thence South and parallel with said west line of Section 9, 300.0 feet; thence West 188.0 feet to the point of beginning and containing 1.30 acres, more or less.

AND all that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4 of SW 1/4) of Section 9, Township 135, Range 37, described as follows: Commencing at the southwest corner of said Section 9, thence on an assumed bearing of North and on and along the west line of said Section 9 a distance of 828 feet to the point of beginning; thence continuing on an assumed bearing of North and on along the west line of said Section a distance of 200 feet; thence on an assumed bearing of East, and at a right angle, a distance of 460 feet; thence on an assumed bearing of South, and parallel with the west line of said Section, a distance of 271 feet; thence on an assumed bearing of West, and at a right angle, a distance of 239 feet; thence on an assumed bearing of North, and parallel with the west line of said Section, a distance of 71 feet; thence on an assumed bearing of West, and at a right angle, 221 feet to the point of beginning, subject to easements and reservations of record, and road right of way, if any.

Section 3. Filing. The City clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State and the County Auditor.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
