



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Nurses participating in the care of patients during the immediate pre and post anesthesia period are licensed by the State of Minnesota and promote their professional growth through the Post Anesthesia Nurses of Minnesota (PANOM), a specialty professional organization; and

WHEREAS: Post anesthesia nurses provide education through conferences, courses, published articles and newsletters with respect to critical nursing observations and techniques, emotional support and patient teaching; and

WHEREAS: Post anesthesia nurses study, discuss, exchange professional knowledge, facilitate cooperation among post anesthesia nurses, physicians and other medical personnel, and collaborate to maintain and upgrade standards of patient care during the immediate pre and post anesthesia period; and

WHEREAS: Post anesthesia nurses are encouraged to achieve designation as a Certified Post Anesthesia Nurse (CPAN) to recognize the specialized body of knowledge and expertise required to safely care for dependent patients during the critical time immediately pre and post anesthesia; and

WHEREAS: Post anesthesia nurses encourage specialization and research in pre and post anesthesia patients and cooperate with universities, government agencies and any other organizations in matters affecting the purposes of the society;
