WHEREAS: Robert Foley and his son, Dr. James Foley have been selected as recipients of the College of St. Thomas Humanitarian of the Year award for 1989; and

WHEREAS: The College of St. Thomas Alumni Association selected Robert and James Foley for their exceptional work with and on behalf of the people of Third World countries, which typifies the values and service for which the College stands; and

WHEREAS: Robert Foley has shown his dedication to our country and its citizens through his work in retirement with the Peace Corps and in providing medical assistance to residents of Third World nations; and

WHEREAS: Dr. James Foley has demonstrated his compassion and concern for his fellow citizens through his medical service for the natives of Honduras, East Africa, Sri Lanka and Guatemala, and his acquisition and distribution of needed medical equipment for those in emerging nations; and


