NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, February 18, 1989 to be


CINDERELLA DAY FOR MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS


in Minnesota in honor of the work of the Metropolitan Society.
