- WHEREAS: The Minneapolis Society for the Blind was founded on March 14, 1914; and
- WHEREAS: It has continued to provide employment (in its Manufacturing Division) for persons who are blind or visually impaired; and
- WHEREAS: Rehabilitation services have been regularly provided to help individuals who are blind learn techniques that will help them toward independent living; and
- WHEREAS: Low Vision services are provided to an increasing number of persons experiencing gradual vision loss; and
- WHEREAS: The Society has embarked on a course of action and service to carry it through the remainder of its first and into its second century; and
- WHEREAS: A year-long celebration of its 75th Anniversary will commence on March 14, 1989;

THE MINNEAPOLIS SOCIETY FOR THE BLIND MONTH


in Minnesota.


