- WHEREAS: Through this dedication in the medical laboratories of the United States a vital contribution has been made to both the quality of patient care and to the preservation of human life itself;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 9-15, 1989 to be

in Minnesota.


