



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota women use their talents, skills, abilities, and sense of justice and commitment to express themselves in a wide variety of activities in communities all over Minnesota, but are not always recognized for the positive contributions they make; and

WHEREAS: The *Marvelous Minnesota Woman* award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual contribution to the community; and

WHEREAS: Josephine Nunn's career of public service includes twelve years as Mayor of Champlin and seventeen years with various Metropolitan Council and metro area committees, including six years as a member of the Metropolitan Council; and

WHEREAS: Josephine Nunn's intelligence, ability to work fairly with others, and willingness to take on tough public issues has earned her the respect of people in the public and private sector who have had the benefit of working with her;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

JOSEPHINE DUNN

to be a *Marvelous Minnesota Woman*, to acknowledge her contribution to the Minnesota community in which we live and to serve as an example of the outstanding talent and commitment which is possessed by Minnesota women.
