



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota women use their talents, skills, abilities, and sense of justice and commitment to express themselves in a wide variety of activities in communities all over Minnesota, but are not always recognized for the positive contributions they make; and

WHEREAS: The Marvelous Minnesota Woman award honors women for their personal accomplishments and acknowledges the significance of each individual contribution to the community; and

WHEREAS: Margaret Revoir's commitment to the well being of the community has focused on job training and the creation and implementation of policy that encourages employment for women, especially displaced homemakers, in recognition of women's financial responsibilities in society and the lack of recognition of women's skills, talents, and abilities that so often impedes access to employment opportunities for women;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

MARGARET REVOIR

to be a Marvelous Minnesota Woman, to acknowledge her contribution to the Minnesota community in which we live and to serve as an example of the outstanding talent and commitment which is possessed by Minnesota women.
