Mollie Hoben's talents as a journalist and educator have found expression as a junior WHEREAS: mothe novem's talents as a journalist and eaucator have found expression as a funior high school English and Special Education teacher, as manager of an award winning community newspaper, as founder of the Minnesota Women's Press, Inc., as publisher of the Women's Press newspaper, and as advocate of feminist writings through her professional activities;
