



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: St. Peter High School is the first place winner in the 1989 Minnesota Vikings "Most Valuable Players" (MVP) Contest; and
- WHEREAS: Two hundred Minnesota high schools participated in this contest, which was co-sponsored by Attorney General Hubert Humphrey's Alliance for a Drug Free Minnesota and the Minnesota Vikings; and
- WHEREAS: The MVP contest was designed to encourage and reward high school students for their drug and alcohol abuse prevention efforts; and
- WHEREAS: Over 92 percent of the St. Peter student body signed pledges to remain drug free for the remainder of the school year; and
- WHEREAS: For winning the contest, the high school is being given a free-of-charge, drug and alcohol free party on February 20, and will be awarded with a \$1,000 Chemical Awareness Scholarship from the Vikings; and
- WHEREAS: St. Peter High School also won the North Stars Challenge, a similar contest, last year;
