




## Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The Centre for Asian and Pacific Islanders (CAPI) is a multi-ethnic organization that helps refugees to help themselves and includes members of the Hmong, Vietnamese, Laotian, Cambodian, and other Asian and Caucasian communities; and
- WHEREAS: Since its creation in 1982, CAPI's employment services have helped thousands of refugees to find work and become financially independent; and
- WHEREAS: CAPI's food shelf is the second largest in Hennepin County and brings food to thousands of low income refugees; and
- WHEREAS: CAPI's Day Care Provider Training Program has helped many Asian women to learn a new profession in the care and nurturing of children; and
- WHEREAS: CAPI's Juvenile Justice System Asian Advocacy Program has made it possible for Asian youth to cope with the difficulties of adjusting to a new culture; and
- WHEREAS: CAPI's represents the unity of the Southeast Asian community and its integration into the new homeland of Minnesota;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the 30th day of March to be

in Minnesota.


