

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Charles Marshall, a native of Illinois, was raised in Greenville and holds a degree from the University of Illinois; and

WHEREAS: He joined Illinois Bell in 1953 as a service engineer in Peoria. During his early career with the Bell System, he held numerous assignments in Illinois and with the American Telephone and Telegraph Company; and

WHEREAS: In January, 1975 Mr. Marshall was appointed Vice President of Texas Operations for Southwestern Bell in Dallas, Texas and in September, 1976 he was named Vice President and Treasurer of AT&T in New York City; and

WHEREAS: In April, 1977 he returned to his home state as President and Chief Executive Officer of Illinois Bell; and

WHEREAS: In October, 1981 he went back to AT&T as Executive Vice President, responsible for developing and managing AT&T's prospective subsidiary involved in customer premises equipment and enhanced services; and

WHEREAS: In January, 1983 he was appointed Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of AT&T Information Systems. In September of 1986, he became Vice Chairman of the Board of AT&T; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Marshall is a Director of AT&T, Hartmarx Corporation, Sonat Inc., New York City Partnership, New York Chamber of Commerce and Industry, National Urban League, United Way of America and President of the University of Illinois Foundation. He also serves as Trustee of the University of Chicago and the American Management Association; and

WHEREAS: Mr. Marshall and his wife, Millicent live in New Jersey. They have four children;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 13, 1989 to be
