WHEREAS: Many of those children are being forced into welfare rolls; and


WHEREAS: On April 27, 1989 a national candlelight vigil will be held "To Light A Spark of Hope For Forgotten Children";

CHILD SUPPORT AWARENESS DAY


in Minnesota.
