The importance of a strong national defense is in concert with our nation's goal of a world at peace; and WHEREAS:

The Reserve Components of our Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps and Coast Guard serve an essential and vital part of our nation's defense; and WHEREAS:

The men and women serving in these reserve forces are patriotic citizens of this state who have dedicated their lives to serving our nation through military service; and WHEREAS:

The sacrifices made by these reservists and their families are in part shared by their equally patriotic and dedicated employers; and WHEREAS:

The strength of our nation and well-being of this state depends upon the understanding of every American of the role played by the reservist, family and employer in preserving our nation's freedom; WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 30, 1989 to be

in Minnesota, and ask all citizens of this state to recognize and commend those employers, both public and private, who encourage and support employee participation in the Guard and Reserve; and to extend the thanks of this community to the families of these reservists for their continued sacrifice and understanding.
