WHEREAS: The Minnesota Court system is a separate, independent and equal branch of government;

WHEREAS: The court system provides a forum for the resolution of disputes by finding facts, interpreting applicable law and ordering its enforcement; and

WHEREAS: The court system is available to all persons, groups and organizations for protection of the personal and property rights provided under the constitution, statutes and commom law of the state; and

WHEREAS: The Honorable Conrad Gaarenstroom has served as Judge in the Fifth Judicial District since November 1968; and

WHEREAS: Judge Gaarenstroom's decisions have always been guided by the principles of fairness, impartiality, equal access and timeliness; and

WHEREAS: Judge Gaarenstroom has always administered justice in an open, consistent, predictable and courteous manner consistent with the highest ideals of public service; and

WHEREAS: All who know Judge Gaarenstroom respect the high standard he has set for public service, personal sacrifice and personal and judicial integrity;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 17th to be

JUDGE CONRAD GAARENSTROOM DAY

in Minnesota.
