

## **Proclamation**

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is rich in natural resources and beauty; and

WHEREAS: I believe that every citizen should contribute to keeping his or her environment clean and healthful, and should work together to preserve clean air, fresh water and the natural beauty of his or her surroundings; and

WHEREAS: Keep America Beautiful Month has organized millions of Americans for more than seventeen years in a nationwide effort to improve the community environment by establishing recycling centers, restoring beachfronts and landscaping; and

WHEREAS: Keep America Beautiful, Inc., the national, nonprofit, public service organization responsible for involving individuals in community improvement, originated KAB Month to focus attention on the efforts of concerned Americans;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April 1989 to be

KEEP AMERICA BEAUTIFUL MONTH

in Minnesota, and I ask all citizens from business, civic groups, government agencies and other organizations to do their share not only during Keep America Beautiful Month but throughout the year.
