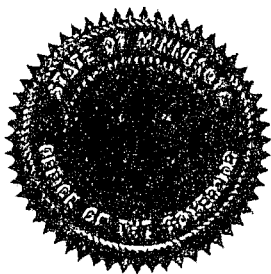
WHEREAS: Metropolitan-Mount Sinai Medical Center's mission is to provide excellent, comprehensive health care services for people throughout the state; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 28-29 to be



in Minnesota.




