WHEREAS: Verna and Ted are proud grandparents of thirteen grandchildren; and

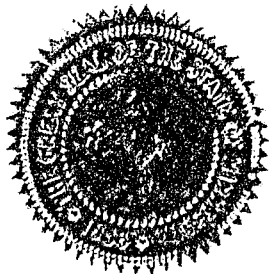
WHEREAS: Verna worked as the shop steward at Continental Can, and she belonged to the Grain Millers Union and the Electrical Workers Union; and
