WHEREAS: Minnesotans are avid participants and spectators in all kinds of winter sports; and

WHEREAS: Hockey is a favorite Minnesota activity and is enjoyed year round by people of all ages; and

WHEREAS: Hockey plays an important role in the life and vitality of Minnesota, requiring tremendous skill and agility, and providing spirited competition for spectators and participants alike; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota will be the center of hockey activity from March 2 through April 3, 1989, when several major hockey events will take place in our state; and

WHEREAS: From March 2 through 4, the State High School hockey tournament will be held at the St. Paul Civic Center; and

WHEREAS: On March 5 and 6, the Civic Center will host the WCHA Final Four Playoff Championship in St. Paul; and

WHEREAS: The St. Paul Civic Center will host the NCAA Final Four Hockey Championships, March 30, 31 and April 1, drawing outstanding hockey players from our nation's colleges and universities to our state for three days of exciting competition; and

WHEREAS: The ninth annual Hobey Baker Memorial Award will be presented to the Outstanding College Hockey Player of the Year at the Decathlon Athletic Club of Bloomington, April 3; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans are pleased to host these tremendous days of hockey action;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim March 2 through April 3, 1989 to be
