




Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The Actors Theatre in St. Paul has presented works and artists from South Africa, Czechoslovakia, Ireland, Trinidad, Hungary, and the Soviet Union; and
- WHEREAS: The Actors Theatre members believe that cultural exchange is an important contribution toward mutual understanding and peaceful relations between nations; and
- WHEREAS: During the 1988-89 season the "sister theatre" relationship with Yermolova Theatre of Moscow is being further developed with its first major undertaking—the exchange of directors and designers; and
- WHEREAS: Michael Andrew Miner, Artistic Director of Actors Theatre directed Clifford Cdet's *AWAKE AND SING!* with the Yermolova Company in Moscow, opening on February 10, 1989; and
- WHEREAS: Valerie Fokin, Artistic Director of the Yermolova Company, is directing The Actors Theatre Company in Alexander Vampilov's *LAST SUMMER IN CHULIMSK*, opening in St. Paul on April 21, 1989; and
- WHEREAS: This will be the first time that an American audience can participate in an artistic exchange of this magnitude;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 21, 1989 to be

ACTORS THEATRE-YERMOLOVA COMPANY DAY


in Minnesota.
