



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The man made and natural disaster has brought distress and suffering to the people of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The American Red Cross is designated by the Congress of the United States in Public Law 4, 58th Congress, January 5, 1905 (33 Stat. 599, as amended: 36 U.S.C. 1), as a voluntary agency responsible for a disaster relief; and

WHEREAS: The American Red Cross is already extending on a grant basis, assistance to those in need in Minnesota in grave hour of emergency and will continue providing this assistance in coordination with other private organizations and government disaster recovery agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby recognize the American Red Cross as the agency to meet the immediate human needs of individuals and families affected by the disaster, and urge that all citizens and agencies, both public and private, in Minnesota give the Red Cross their full support and cooperation; and



All such donations will be used by the Red Cross in the humane task of providing assistance to our people who have disaster-caused needs.


