



Proclamation

WHEREAS: On May 6th, the 7th district V.F.W. and the Minneapolis Fire Relief Association will be sponsoring a Public Safety Day at the new Minneapolis Convention Center; and

WHEREAS: Law enforcement, fire, and emergency medical equipment and personnel from Anoka and Hennepin Counties will be displayed; and

WHEREAS: Other activities will include demonstrations by various groups and a bicycle rodeo for kids, with one hundred bicycles being given away; and

WHEREAS: It is important to recognize law enforcement officers, who day after day, hour by hour, serve, not only as law enforcement agents of this state to protect life and property, but are indeed friend, neighbor and guardian; and
