

Proclamation

WHEREAS: April 27, 1989, is the First Asian-Pacific Minnesotans Day At The Capitol sponsored by the State Council on Asian-Pacific Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: The Asian-Pacific Community of the State of Minnesota will be assembled for the first time on this day at the State Capitol to meet with Minnesota Legislators, Government, Corporate, Education and Non-Profit Agency Representatives to discuss important legislative issues; and

WHEREAS: The cultural heritage, history, customs, values, religion, philosophy, and tradition of the Asian-Pacific people will be presented, including musical performances, with continuing education credits for teachers, counselors and service providers;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 27,

ASIAN-PACIFIC MINNESOTANS DAY
AT THE CAPITOL

in Minnesota.
