WHEREAS: The Finns settled in Minnesota in 1864 or near this year; and

WHEREAS: The Finns worked in lumber camps and iron mines of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Finns contributed to the local and state Government; and

WHEREAS: The Finns contributed to the education system of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Finns contributed to the business communities of the State of Minnesota; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the twenty-eighth day of May, 1989 to be

FINNISH - AMERICAN DAY

In Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-nine, and of the State the one hundred thirty-first.
