WHEREAS: The National Student Campaign Against Hunger is a student-run organization to fight hunger; and

WHEREAS: Students in Minnesota's colleges in the Twin Cities, Duluth, St. Cloud, Moorhead and Winona, along with students from around the country, are joining forces to fight hunger and clean up their cities; and

WHEREAS: This Great Hunger Cleanup will provide a sense of community and self-help which is needed in our area, while meeting the needs of those less fortunate; and


WHEREAS: On Saturday, April 15, 1989, students from the Twin Cities will be working at local community service projects while raising money for local and worldwide hunger coalitions;

in Minnesota, in honor of the needy throughout this state, the nation, and the world.


