during the observance of the 39th anniversary of the commencement of the war;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 25-30, 1989 to be

KOREAN WAR VETERANS WEEK

in Minnesota, and encourage all citizens to join in recognizing these brave and proud war veterans.
