WHEREAS: Throughout our nation's history, Americans have been called upon to protect freedom and liberty on foreign shores; and

WHEREAS: From 1950-1953, brave and noble Americans joined United Nations forces from 15 other nations to defend and preserve the freedom of the Republic of Korea for generations to come; and

WHEREAS: The conclusion of the Korean conflict resulted in the establishment of the demilitarized zone and peace for the South Koreans; and

WHEREAS: It is fitting that we pay tribute to America's fearless heroes of the Koreans War during the observance of the 39th anniversary of the commencement of the war;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 25-30, 1989 to be

in Minnesota, and encourage all citizens to join in recognizing these brave and proud war veterans.
