WHEREAS: The practice of modern medicine at the exacting standards we now enjoy would be

impossible without the scientific tests performed daily in the medical laboratory; and

WHEREAS: Maintenance of these standards and progress towards improvement in the quality of

laboratory services depends on the dedicated efforts of professional clinical

laboratory scientists; and

WHEREAS: Through this dedication, the medical laboratories of the United States have made a

vital contribution to the quality of health care;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 9-15, 1989 to be

MEDICAL LABORATORY WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to recognize and support the vital service provided by the laboratory practitioner for the good of all citizens.
