WHEREAS: In Minnesota, more than 58,000 children suffer from severe emotional disturbances, and more than 30,000 adults from serious and persistent mental illness; and

WHEREAS: An acute lack of understanding concerning the facts of emotional disturbance and mental illness exists in the public today; and

WHEREAS: The month of May is being observed throughout the Nation as Mental Health Month to call attention to measures which must be taken in the fight against emotional disturbance and mental illness;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of May to be


in Minnesota, and commend highly the citizens of the State, the mental health programs, and all those dedicated to the mental health cause.


