Federal, state and local units of government have taken action to preserve and protect WHEREAS:

these waters; and

In recognition of the activities planned by local units of the government, watershed WHEREAS:

associations, outdoor enthusiasts, and private citizens to promote public awareness of water resources for protection, use and enjoyment; and

The State of Minnesota has taken a leading role in the prudent management and use of WHEREAS:
